Tombstone inscriptions at Sappington Cemetery were copied in July 1960 by Mrs. Dempsey E. Radford and Mrs. Isabel S. Giulvezan. The tombstones were chalked and re-checked in August 1966 by Mrs. Giulvezan and Mrs. Willis M. Reals of Crestwood, who is in charge of preserving the Sappington Cemetery as an historic landmark, and corrections made on this list.

Three inscriptions could not be deciphered:

Mrs. Ja---- Bowles

E.L. (initials from footstone) who was buried near the Longs, died 1835, age 17 years 6 months 27 days

Henry S. ----- (stone damaged) died July 28, 1870, age 50 years 4 months 15 days

Three small stones were found near the Sappington graves with initials S.G.S., G.E.P., G.L.S.

Several of the stones have been badly damaged since the inscriptions were copied in 1960.

As noted in this list, the Gosken tombstone was not found in 1966, nor markers at the graves of Richard Wells and Joseph Wells.

The inscription on the double tombstone of John and Jemima Sappington is almost illegible now.

BELLEFONTAINE

In this region, originally known as Bellefontaine, the first permanent American settlement in the new territory was located. The first settlers located here in 1779. The region took its name from "La Belle Fontaine" or "Beautiful Spring" which still flows a quarter mile west of here.

Capt. James Moore

"Captain James Moore was born in Maryland in 1750. He came from Kentucky with George Rogers Clark but returned to his old home. Later he was the leader of a colony, coming to Illinois in 1781, and settled at Belle Fontaine, near Waterloo, in Monroe County. He received his commission as captain from Governor Patrick Henry. He died on the old Moore farm (1788) and lies buried in the Belle Fontaine Cemetery, one mile south of Waterloo."

Lt. William Biggs

William Biggs was a brother of Catherine, wife of James Moore. He held a commission as a Lieutenant and was a soldier under George Rogers Clark. He settled near Belle Fontaine in 1796, was first sheriff of St. Clair County, served in the first General Assembly of the Territory, and served

many years as a judge and in the legislature. He died at Colonel Judy's mill in 1827 and lies in the Belle Fontaine Cemetery.

Enoch Moore

"Enoch Moore, son of Captain James Moore, was born in the old blockhouse at Belle Fontaine in 1782, being the first child born of American parents in Illinois. Served as a 'Ranger' and was Captain in the War of 1812; was Clerk of the Circuit Court and afterwards Judge of Probate of Monroe County during the territorial period. Representatives from Monroe County to the Illinois Constitutional Convention of 1818: Caldwell Cairns and Enoch Moore."

Sacred to the memory of Gen. James B. Moore who departed this life
July 10, 1840

(James Biggs Moore, born Oct. 8, 1780, was a son of James Moore. He embarked in various business enterprises, and for some years traded on the Ohio and Mississippi rivers between New Orleans and Pittsburgh, making his voyages in a keel boat. He abandoned the boat business to settle three miles northeast of the present town of Waterloo, on what was known as the "tan yard farm". He here invested in a large tanning enterprise, at that time, perhaps, the largest west of the Alleghenies. He organized a company of rangers in the War of 1812 and was commissioned its

captain. He was appointed sheriff of Monroe County by Gov. Ninian Edwards, and was the first to fill that office after the organization of the county. He was sheriff several years and afterward for two terms represented the county in the State Legislature. He was son of James Moore; he married Sarah Shook and they had eight children.)

James C. Moore, died Oct. 16, 1844, aged 24 years 3 months 5 days
(Son of James Biggs Moore.)

Lewis G. Shook, born July 15, 1850, died aged about 6 months

John Milton Moore, born at Bellefontaine farm October 18, 1786, died September 23, 1844, aged 57 years 11 months 5 days
(John Milton Moore, son of James Moore, became surveyor for St. Clair County at the age of 16. At the outbreak of the War of 1812 he joined the army and served throughout the war. Upon his return he took up his chosen profession - surveyor and civil engineer.)

Mary Moore, wife of J. M. Moore, born in Virginia, January 25, 1794, emigrated to Monroe County, Illinois, 1797, died March 15, 1873
